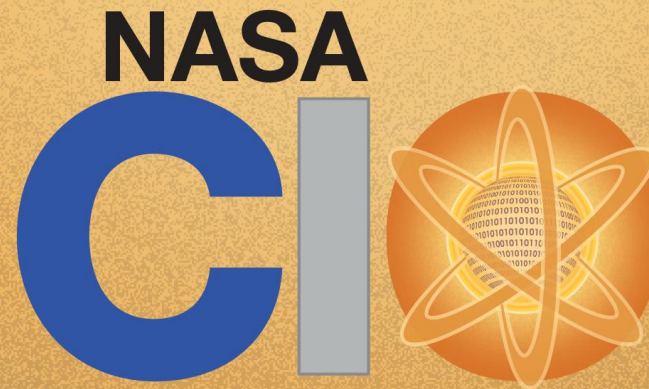




Collaborating Securely in a Remote Workplace





About the Presenters

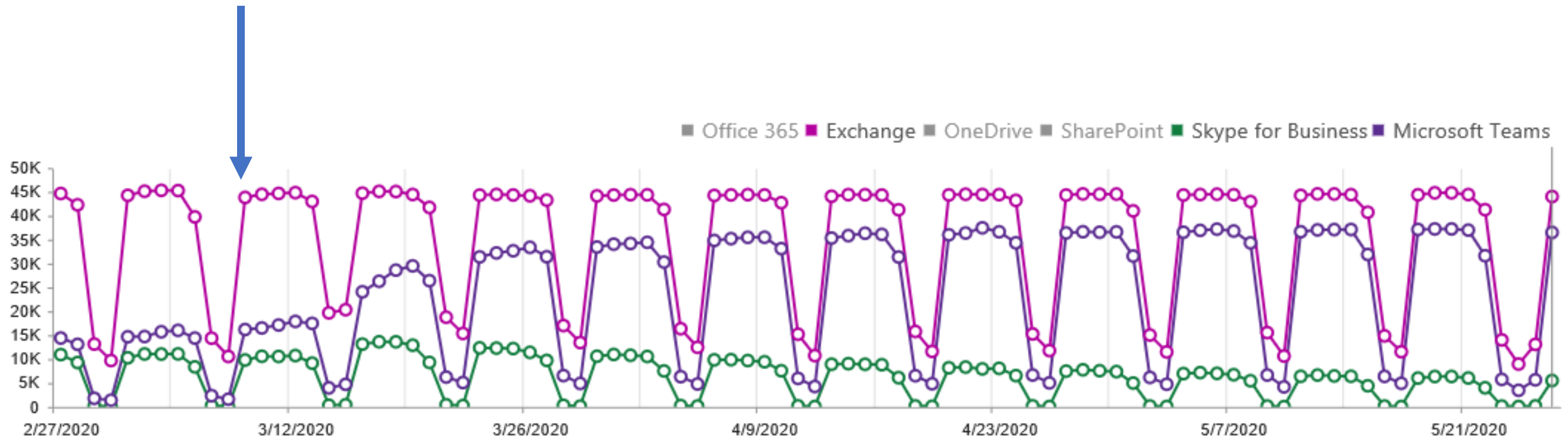
