Air Shipment Plan

- December 22:
 - Toolsets & spares (TS-1) AFRC to Philippines
- January 28 (AFRC to Korea)
 - 1. Toolsets & spares (TS-2)
 - Cache of spares (Spares) (Stays in Korea until/if needed)
 - 3. Crew survival Winter Clothing
 - 4. Personal winter clothing
- Feb. 14:
 - TS-1 Philippines to Malaysia
- Feb. 27:
 - TS-2 Korea to Thailand

TS-1: Tools/spares needed x operations in the Philippines.

TS-2: Tools/spares needed x operations in Korea.

Spares cache: stays in Korea until needed

Survival gear returns to the US on DC-8 after campaign.

Winter clothing ships back to the US after campaign.

TS-2 to Malaysia; then back to USA.

TS-2 to Thailand; then back to USA.



ASIA-AQ Basing Locations

• The Philippines:

- Arrival airports: CRK (10min to hotel), MNL (3.5hr+ to hotel)
- Hotel/Per diem location: Clark
- Operations location: Clark International Airport

• Republic of Korea:

- Arrival airport: ICN (1.5hr+ to Osan AB)
- Hotel/Per diem location: Pyeongtaek
- Operations location: Osan Air Base

Malaysia:

- Arrival Airport: KUL (45min+ to hotel)
- Hotel/Per diem location: Subang (Other)
- Operations location: Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport (SZB)

• Thailand:

- Arrival Airport: BKK (1.5hr to hotel)
- Hotel/Per diem location: Pattaya
- Operations location: U-Tapao Rayong Airport (UTP)



Transportation Plans & Coordination

Car Rentals:

- One-Way Car Rentals to Palmdale, CA:
 - Some personnel fly into LAX / BUR & leave for SE Asia via the DC-8
 - AFRC & ESPO can assist with shuttle vans day before DC-8 transit. Uber/taxis are another option
 - Travelers must make their own car rental reservation/coordination/returns.

Transportation to Hotels

- Philippines (MNL, CRK), S. Korea (ICN), Malaysia (KUL), Thailand (BKK):
 - In early 2024, ESPO will collect arrival details from everyone
 - ESPO will schedule shuttle transportation from airport terminals to hotel for time/date periods with large numbers of people, **not for all arrivals**
 - Information will be provided on taxi/ride-sharing/public transportation available at all locations.

Transportation at Deployment Locations

- No car rentals allowed
- ESPO will coordinate shuttle transportation from designated hotels to/from ASIA-AQ basing locations
